First Ship of 2018 at the Port of Belledune

Belledune NB -The Belledune Port Authority (BPA) officially greeted Captain Kumar Raj, Master of the M.T.M. “Penang”, the first ship to lay anchor at the Port of Belledune in 2018.

The M.T.M. “Penang” is registered in Singapore and her last port of call before arriving in Belledune was Rouen, France. The vessel’s agent is Fundy Shipping., represented by Ms. Nicole Boudreau. The M.T.M. “Penang” docked at the Port of Belledune the morning of January 19^h, 2018, where the vessel is loaded approximately 19,000MT of acid. The next stop for the M.T.M. “Penang” will be at Jorf Lasfar in Morocco.
