## Happening This Month:

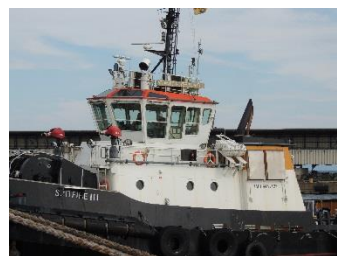
